

Moorside walking club walk 23/June/2019

The walk is approximately 8.5 mile walk around Chatsworth House and estate grounds.

The walk starts at Calton Lees car park and takes in Beeley village, Chatsworth house and Edensor village before returning to the car park at Calton Lees. There are toilets at the start of the walk in the Garden centre next to the car park, also at Chatsworth house approximately half way around. There are good views over the valley from the hillsides. The car park was £3 for the day last time we went.

Calton Lees car park: SK 25875 68566, Explorer OL24, post code DE4 2NX

Time: 9.45 for 10.00am start

The route we take is through Longnor, Monyash, Bakewell, Rowsley.

When you get to Bakewell turn right on the A6 after about three miles you come to Rowsley. Turn left for Beeley [B6012]. Pass through Beeley and after about half a mile you cross a bridge with traffic lights. The car park is shortly after this on the left. It should take about an hour and fifteen minutes from Stoke.

Please bring your own food for morning stop and lunch. We can have an afternoon stop if required.
