- Map:** Explorer 267– Northwich & Delamere Forest
- Grade:** Moderate
- The Route:** Gresty's Waste - Eddisbury Hill – Eddisbury Wood – Pale Heights – Nettleford Wood – The Yeld – Kelsall Village – Castle Hill – Boothsdale – Summertrees – Primrosehill Wood – Gresty's Waste
- Description:** Mostly good paths/tracks, some moderately steep ascents/descents, flatter sections and some lane walking. One busy road crossing where care will be needed. Some muddy sections likely after prolonged or heavy rain. There will be some extensive views from the high points (weather permitting).
- Distance:** Approximately 8.5 miles
- Parking:** Sandstone Trail Car Park at Gresty's Waste - Post Code CW6 0SP – Grid Ref SJ540695
Car sharing would be helpful if possible as this is a popular car park
- If using Sat-Nav this may not take you to the exact location of the car park.
- Toilets:** None on route
- Time:** 09.45 for 10.00 am start
- Directions:** Travel time approximately 50-55 minutes from Blythe Bridge.
Suggested Route: A50 to Sideway then A500 (North), at M6 Jct 16 continue on A500 to its end at Cheerbrook roundabout. Take third exit A51 and continue to follow to the roundabout at end of the Tarporley bypass. Take second exit A49 and after passing the Alvanley Arms on the right take road left B5152. At crossroads (Fishpool Inn on left) turn left onto A54 and at junction with A556 continue ahead then look out for the sign for Gresty's Waste car park. The car park entrance then comes up quickly on the left.
